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**Course description:**

This course is designed to provide new students with a basic understanding of the global trends within food science and technology, the diversity of career opportunities within the industry, planning for a career and opportunities for professional development. During the course, the students will be introduced to several representative of the Department faculty, staff and students.

**Assignments**

Students are required to submit a one-page summary of observations and interpretations from each of the seven course sessions. These summaries can be submitted electronically and must be received within one week after a given class session. Course credit will not be granted unless all seven summaries are submitted. In addition, all students will be required to submit the first draft (at minimum) of their four-year program plan before the end of the semester.
